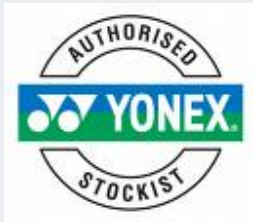

When? How? Why?

Saturday and Sunday mornings and afternoons, 1 hour group coaching sessions for children of all ages from 5 years old and upwards.

Small groups of 5/6 children of similar age, learning the basic fundamentals in a fun, safe environment.

Each level will last for six weeks on consecutive weekends

All children will receive a passport upon registration with targets and goals to achieve during the 6 week course and will also receive a certificate upon completion.
